Criteria requested for QTEM Applicants:

A. Overall criteria (assessed by each QTEM Academic Partner)

1. English proficiency
2. Quantitative proficiency
3. International experience
4. Professional / extra-academic experience

B. Common criterion to all QTEM Participants: **GMAT/GRE score**

- GMAT or GMAT equivalent score of 650+ (score between 650 and 600 can be considered for QTEM with exceptional profile)
- Test taken within the last 3 years
