# **QTEM Applicants**



### **Criteria requested for QTEM Applicants:**

- A. Overall criteria (assessed by each QTEM Academic Partner)
  - 1. English proficiency
  - 2. Quantitative proficiency
  - 3. International experience
  - 4. Professional / extra-academic experience
- B. Common criterion to all QTEM Participants: <u>GMAT/GRE</u> <u>score</u>
  - GMAT or GMAT equivalent score of 650+ (score between 650 and 600 can be considered for QTEM with exceptional profile)
  - Test taken within the last 3 years
