VISA Procedure	<p>Certificate of Eligibility (COE) and Certificate of Admission will be sent to a home institution with the following schedule. Course registration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students can register maximum 24 credits each semester including Japanese language courses. Course list for 2016/2017 will be updated in January-February 2016. Some students cannot register the courses as they want if many students apply for the course. (There will be a random selection.) As of AY2016, exchange students are not charged for taking Japanese language courses. However, please be advised that it is subject to change. Course registration takes place upon arrival. Students can drop courses only offered by SoC within 6 credits after the registration period.
